## Additional requirements

### **Level of applicants**

The majority of Erasmus exchange agreements with UK LEEDS01 are at undergraduate level and therefore it is rare students are allowed to take modules taught at PG level. It is at the discretion of

the teaching department at the University of Leeds to allow Erasmus students a place on a postgraduate module.

### **Accommodation**

The University of Leeds will offer Study Abroad students a place in University student accommodation subject to the students applying before the application deadline of April 15<sup>th</sup>.

### **Orientation programme**
