### Additional requirements

The University of Murcia will not be able to accept incoming students from subject areas not covered by the bilateral agreement. However, students can enrol in any extra subject from other subject areas provided that: 1) they do not represent the majority of the Learning Agreement, 2) the academic advisor is in agreement with the Learning Agreement prior to the arrival of the student.

The University of Murcia has adapted its facilities in order to allow access to people with disabilities. Furthermore, there is an office, within the University, which provides guidance and assistance to students with disabilities and special needs. Some of the services they render include the following: access to adapted computers, technical support, academic support, and psychological help.
